

Policy on School of Social Sciences Special Initiatives Fund

Goal:	Support faculty scholarly and community building activity in the School of Social Sciences by supplementing required Department/Program/Center financial support.
Funding For:	Lecture series Book workshops Commemorative events (anniversary celebrations, memorials) Conferences Grant-development workshops
How Much:	\$2,000-\$10,000 per proposal. Up to \$100,000 total per year will be awarded. These funds <u>must be accompanied</u> by Department/Program/Center financial support for the proposed activity.
Who:	Academic Senate Members in the School of Social Sciences. Proposals can be submitted by individual faculty members or by groups of faculty. Program will fund at most one activity from any faculty member at a time.
Project Length:	Up to 1 year
Process:	Decisions will be made by the Assistant Dean, Associate Deans, and the Dean.

Summary	Also to be submitted via the online portal: A brief description (maximum 100 words) for a general audience of the proposed activity and its impact, to be used in public communication about divisional activities.
